


## **Gateway Marriott Hotel**

This database is password protected for your protection. You may already know the password. It is the name of the school's sports team mascot. Type the team name in lower case identically in both the user ID and password slots.

If you do not see your friend's email address on the database, check with your friend's class secretary to see if he or she has a mailing address.
